## PRACTICING YOUR POSITION

In Christ, a Christian's position, his standing as a Son of God (Gal 3:26; Col 2:10), is perfect (1 John 3:9; 2 Cor 5:21). However, in practice he often falls short of perfection (Rom 7:18-25a; 1 John 2:1). The Christian life is the experience of becoming in practice what a Christian is in position (1 John 3:2). For every truth about one's POSITION in the New Testament, there is a matching PRACTICE that Christians should follow.
